Among various vanadium forms, vanadyl sulfate (VOSO₄)₃- has drawn attention for its antioxidant activity. However, the exact pharmacological activity of VOSO₄)₃- is still unclear. The purpose of this study was to investigate the effect of VOSO₄)₃- in various animal models. The effects of VOSO₄)₃- on serum uric acid levels and a phosphodiesterase (PDE) activity in splenocytes from mice were examined. To test the antioxidative effect of VOSO₄)₃-, we investigated its activity in a 2,2,2-trifluoroethanol (TFE)-induced mouse hepatic injury model and an isoproterenol (ISO)-induced myocardial infarction model. In addition, the effect of VOSO₄)₃- on the enzymatic and nonenzymatic antioxidant systems was also examined. A reduction in serum uric acid levels was observed in mice administered VOSO₄)₃-, although the mechanism for this reduction remains unknown. VOSO₄)₃- induced a decrease in the ISO- and TFE-induced elevated serum creatine kinase levels, a reduction in myocardial infarct size, and a decrease in hepatic MDA levels in mice. However, the effects of VOSO₄)₃- on the enzymatic and nonenzymatic antioxidant systems were inconsistent.
